GDPR Policy

1 Scope

5.1 Policy Statements

We will live up to our policy by:

Ensuring that processing must be lawful, fair, and transparent to the data subject.

Only processing a minimum of data for the legitimate purposes specified explicitly to the data subject when the data is collected.

Ensuring that stored data is valid and up-to-date and only store it for as long as necessary for the specified purpose or defined by law.

Ensuring processing is handled in such a way as to ensure appropriate security, integrity, and confidentiality.

Appointing a data controller who is responsible for GDPR compliance in accordance with the relevant national legislation.
